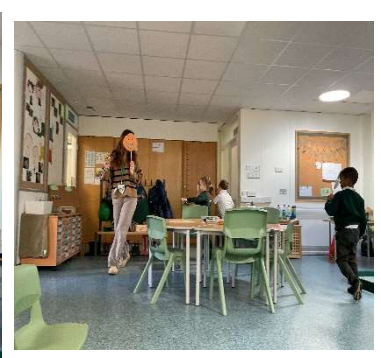


Welcome

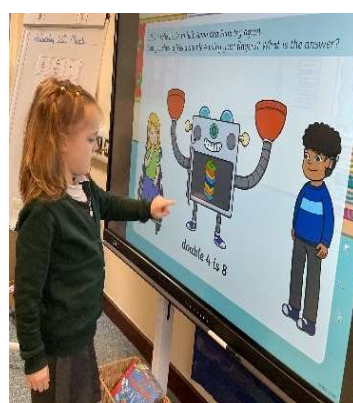
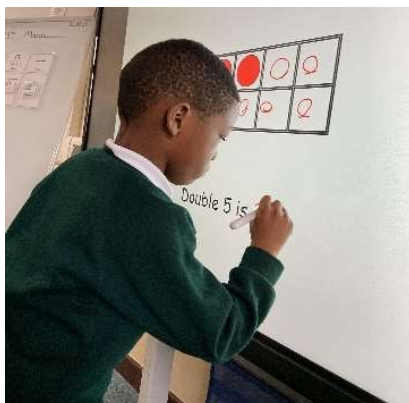


Hello and welcome to this week's news. The children have continued to work hard, both inside and outside the classroom. It has been lovely to have the classroom doors open and spend more time learning outside in the warm spring sun.

In literacy this week we have been enjoying our new 'Once Upon a Time' story, The Gingerbread Man. The children have enjoyed joining in with the repeated phrases and have also used role play and finger puppets to sequence the story. We then tasted gingerbread biscuits, before decorating our own Gingerbread man.



In Numeracy this week we have been learning about doubles. First, we worked hard to secure, understand and use the vocabulary double. We then used a range of practical resources, played lots of games and challenged each other to improve our fluency by using Minute Maths and Hit the Button. Some of us are getting super speedy at recalling key number facts.



In Science this week we have been exploring floating and sinking. We thought carefully about why we thought some objects float and why some objects sink. We collected objects from around the classroom and discussed the material and their properties. We then used this knowledge to make predictions before testing our theories.



This term we have been working hard to develop our love of reading. We continue to share lots of books at school, both fiction and non-fiction, to support our learning. We have also worked hard to read regularly at home too. Well, done to everyone!
