And what a term it's been!

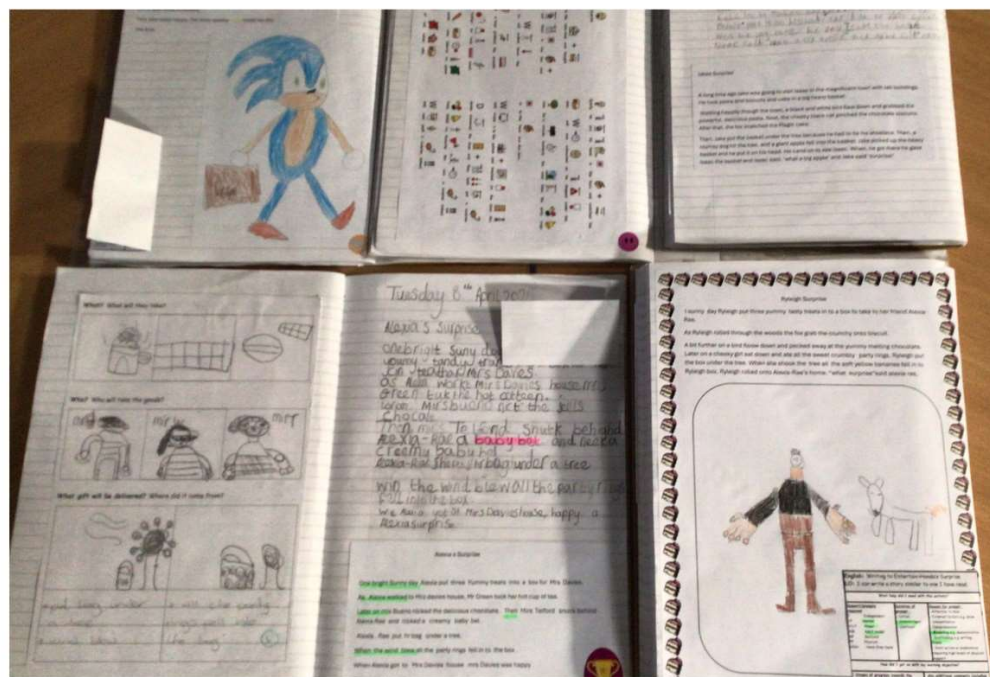
It has been lovely to see the children so happy in school; working hard and enjoying the sunny weather. We are, as always, so very proud of them all.

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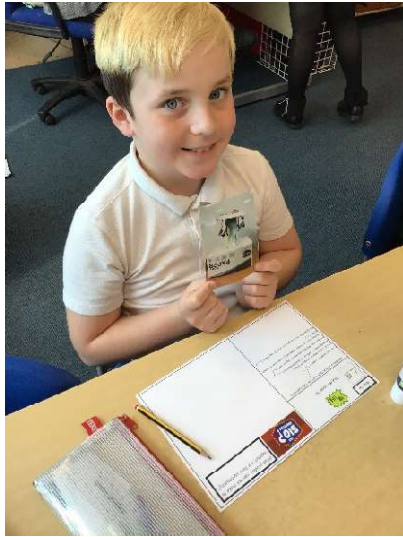
# Spanish
