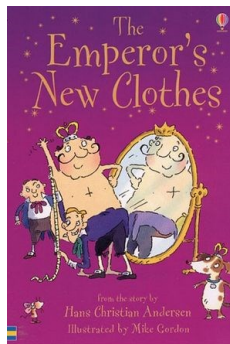

## Numeracy

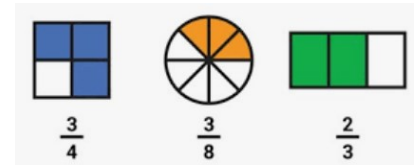
In Numeracy some of us have been working on multiplication and division and have been:

- ♦ Understanding the numerators of non-unit fractions
