

News from the Hollinswood Hub: 2nd June 2025

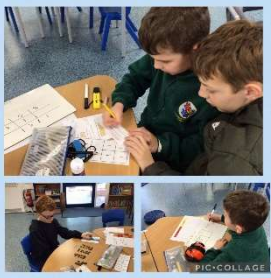


Hello everyone and welcome back to another half term at the hub. The children have all returned to school well rested and ready to start working hard. We have already seen some great work this week.

We then used what we had found out to create our own digestive system model.

Meanwhile, Toby and Isaac joined their link class to find out what happens to our food as it works its way through our body and comes out as waste.



Also this week, Jake and George joined their link class for a visit to Boscobel House as an introduction to their new history topic. The boys both had a fabulous day and enjoyed learning about King Charles II escape from Oliver Cromwell.
