



Children have had an amazing first swimming session. I am so proud of how well they all did!

In Sensory Explore and My Topic children have enjoyed a fruit themed week. They have explored fruit in different media including foam, yogurt and lentils, completed fruit jigsaws, explored citrus water and rolled painted fruit down ramps. They have designed and made fruit kebabs and utilised their cutting skills to make fruit appropriate sizes for their kebab stick.

In the role play area we have had a pizza shop. The children have really enjoyed making and tasting their own pizza made from wraps and pitta bread. They chose their topping and grated their own cheese.

In Play and Leisure, we have started to explore a range of jigsaws and other tabletop games. We are going to use an increased selection next week too.

Within Literacy sessions we have started to read, 'Ketchup On Your Cornflakes'. Children have found the appropriate 'what' and 'where' words on a word mat and answered the question, 'Would you like...' for each of the options. Questions have included some lovely ones, such as, 'Would you like ketchup on your chips?' and some not so popular ones such as, 'Would you like ketchup on your toes?'.

Children have really enjoyed our music song this week, 'Beep Beep' performed by The Playmates (1960) especially the part where they were able to honk the horn! Children used instruments to play at different tempos.
