We are all very proud of how hard everyone has been working.

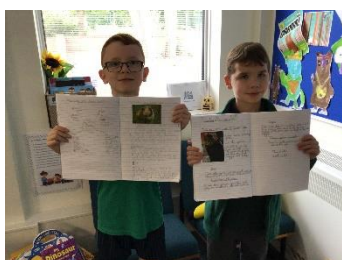


## Maths

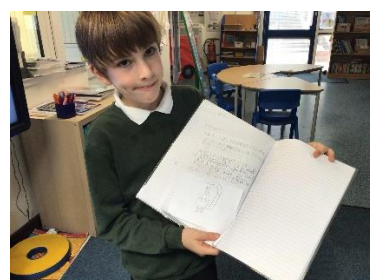
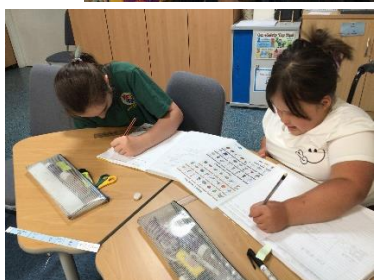
