In Literacy, the children have enjoyed listening to the opening chapter of 'Beauty and the Beast' They focused on using adjectives to describe the prince and used colourful semantics to construct simple sentences. The children also chose adjectives to describe the enchanted forest. They worked hard to construct simple sentences and identified the describing words.

In Storytime, the children listened to 'The Little Red Hen' by Paul Galdone.



Numeracy

This week in Numeracy, the children have started a new topic: Place Value. They have completed an activity involving sorting shapes and objects using different sets of criteria. Some children have enjoyed completing missing number tracks and have identified two-digit numbers using numicon as well pictorial representations.



PSHE

In PSHE, the children have started a new jigsaw puzzle piece: Being Me in My World. They have looked at a selection of pictures showing children playing together and have identified 'happy' and 'unhappy' children. The children talked about the importance of allowing each other to join in games and activities at playtime. They enjoyed working together as part of a team to complete a selection of fun activities in the classroom.



Topic

As part of our topic 'People of the Past' the children have been learning about Queen Elizabeth I. They have remembered some facts and answered questions using an information mat. The children enjoyed drawing a portrait of Queen Elizabeth I and thought carefully about the responsibilities of a ruler. They also thought about the role of a headteacher and chose some new rules for Haughton School.
