Literacy

In Literacy, the children have enjoyed listening to the next chapter of 'Beauty and the Beast'. They have worked hard on using their phonic knowledge to identify initial sounds and have labelled a picture of Mrs Potts. The children have used colourful semantics to construct simple sentences to describe her character. In addition, they have labelled a picture of a rose and have matched a short sentence to describe each part of the flower.

In Storytime, the children listened to 'Guess How Much I Love You' by Sam McBratney.



Numeracy

This week in Numeracy, the children have focused well to complete counting activities. They have circled a given number of objects up to 20 and have solved simple word problems. Some children have continued to enjoy Place Value. They have used the ten frames to calculate the total number by counting the tens and ones. In addition, the children have represented a given two-digit number using the dienes.



PSHE

In PSHE, the children have continued to work on our jigsaw puzzle piece: Being Me in My World. They have watched a video exploring the United Nations Convention on the rights of the child and have discussed the importance of feeling safe, loved, and happy. The children looked at a selection of photographs and sorted them into two groups, children who are learning, eating, playing and happy compared to children who do not have the opportunity to attend school and must do physical work.



Topic

As part of our topic 'People of the Past' the children have been learning about Christopher Columbus. They have listened carefully to his life story as an explorer. The children looked at the ships he sailed in and had lots of fun making their own boats. They enjoyed testing them to see if they would float. The children have also been learning about native Americans and enjoyed creating an Indian headdress using collage and mixed media.
