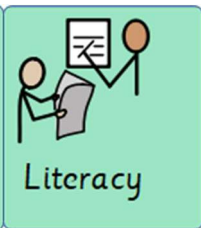
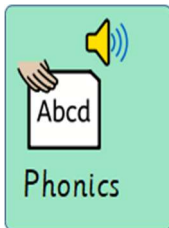
Albie and Haz have also started to link with their year group peers for P.E. They have had an amazing time and made lots of new friends, well done boys!



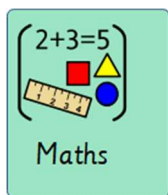
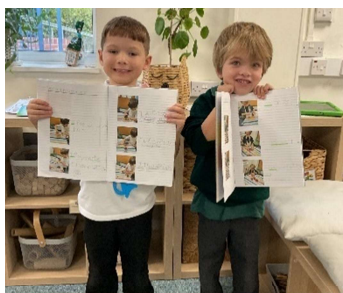
Music

The children have really enjoyed our hub music session this week, with Emily from In-Harmony. The children have been learning how to sign the 'hello and goodbye' song and used instruments to clap, bang or shake to a beat. We particularly enjoyed singing with the microphone- it was great fun!!!!





In literacy and phonics, the children have been working hard to apply their growing phonic knowledge to their writing. The year 2 children have been using time conjunctions to write a set of instructions and the year 1 children have worked hard to improve their letter formation. In addition to this, we have all worked extra hard to use finger spaces and full stops consistently.



In maths, some children have been revisiting counting in 10s, before counting forward and back across numbers to 100. While other children have been finding 1 more and one less, before counting back from a given number within 20.

Thank you for your on-going support, it is much appreciated.

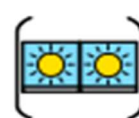
