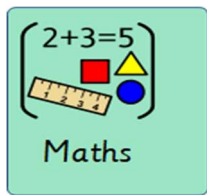




Welcome

Hello and welcome to our last newsletter for this half term.

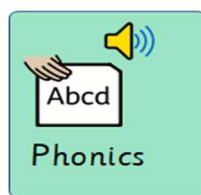

Maths

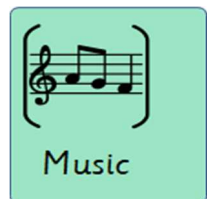

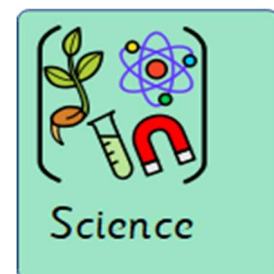
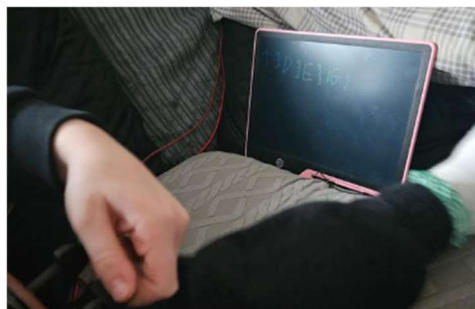
Phonics

This week, the children have been very busy applying their growing phonic knowledge to their reading and writing. While in maths, some children have continued to show their understanding of numbers to 20 when problem solving, and others have continued to work with numbers to 100.

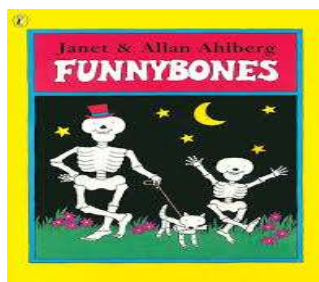
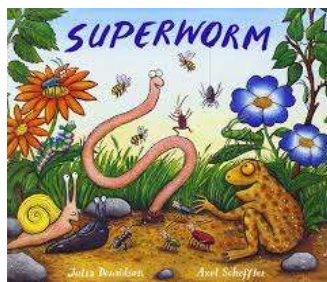
