


In literacy and phonics, the children have continued to work hard to apply their growing phonic knowledge to their reading and writing, across the curriculum. They have worked extremely hard this week to complete their 'First of the Month' writing task, as they describe their own experiences of bonfire night, before creating firework artwork.















Firstly, the children visited our favourite tree to observe the changes that had taken place over the holiday. The children noticed that all the leaves had now changed colour and that the tree had lost most of its leaves. Also, in science this week the children have been exploring Everyday materials. The children have been learning to identify and group objects by the materials they are made from. Some children then grouped objects by their properties.









In music, the children enjoyed singing and signing to the 'Hello and 'Goodbye songs. They used different parts of their bodies to feel the beat, before playing percussion instruments to play to a beat. Our amazing year 2 children have enjoyed playing their violins in their link class. Avery even joined Emily to lead the session, well done Avery!









In topic this week, the year 1 children have continued to learn about superheroes, by enjoying the text- Super Daisy. The children sequenced the story and created sentences to describe each of the characters, before making their own puffy paint to create a 3D Planet Pea'!















