Literacy

In Literacy this week, the children listened to the next chapter of 'Beauty and the Beast.' They enjoyed watching a clip from the Disney film showing a conversation between Belle and the Beast. The children worked hard to match direct speech to each character and enjoyed acting out the scene with a partner.

Numeracy

In Numeracy, the children have been continuing their work on addition and subtraction. They practised using part-whole models to make number bonds to 10 and 20 and used these to write related number facts and sentences. Some children also extended their learning by exploring number bonds to 100 using Base 10 equipment to support and consolidate their understanding. The children have been working hard to spot number patterns and explain their thinking.



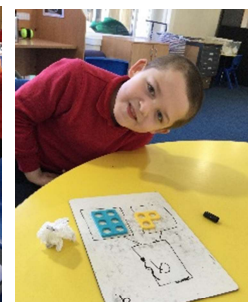
Topic

The children have continued to enjoy our new topic: What's It Made Of? This week they have been learning about wood and where it comes from. The children began by identifying a variety of objects made from wood, then carried out an investigation to explore the characteristics of this material. Each child chose an item made from wood and used descriptive words to talk about its properties, such as how it looks, feels and what it can be used for.



PSHE

The children have started a new topic: Celebrating Difference. This week they have been learning about the different things that influence us and the choices we make. They especially enjoyed exploring optical illusions and pictures that can trick our minds. The children also took part in a sorting activity where they looked at a range of everyday items, including animals, foods, and everyday objects, and decided which ones they liked and disliked. This activity helped them to realise that everyone's likes and dislikes are unique and that's what makes us all different and special.
