We really have had an amazing term here at the hub and we are so very proud of everything our wonderful children have achieved.

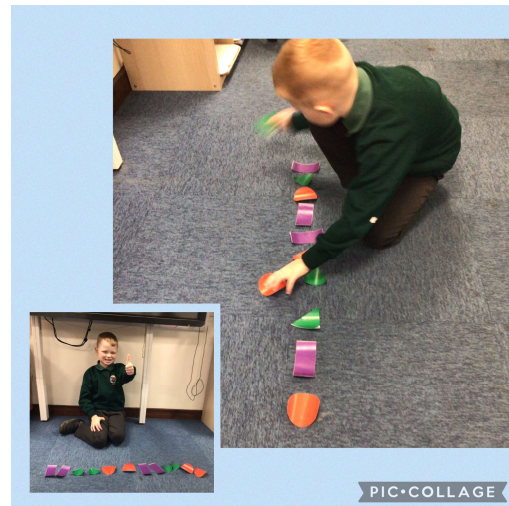


In Maths this week, we have been finishing off our work on shape. After the holidays, we will be starting our new topics.

Thank you to Kathy and her amazing team for our tasty treat!

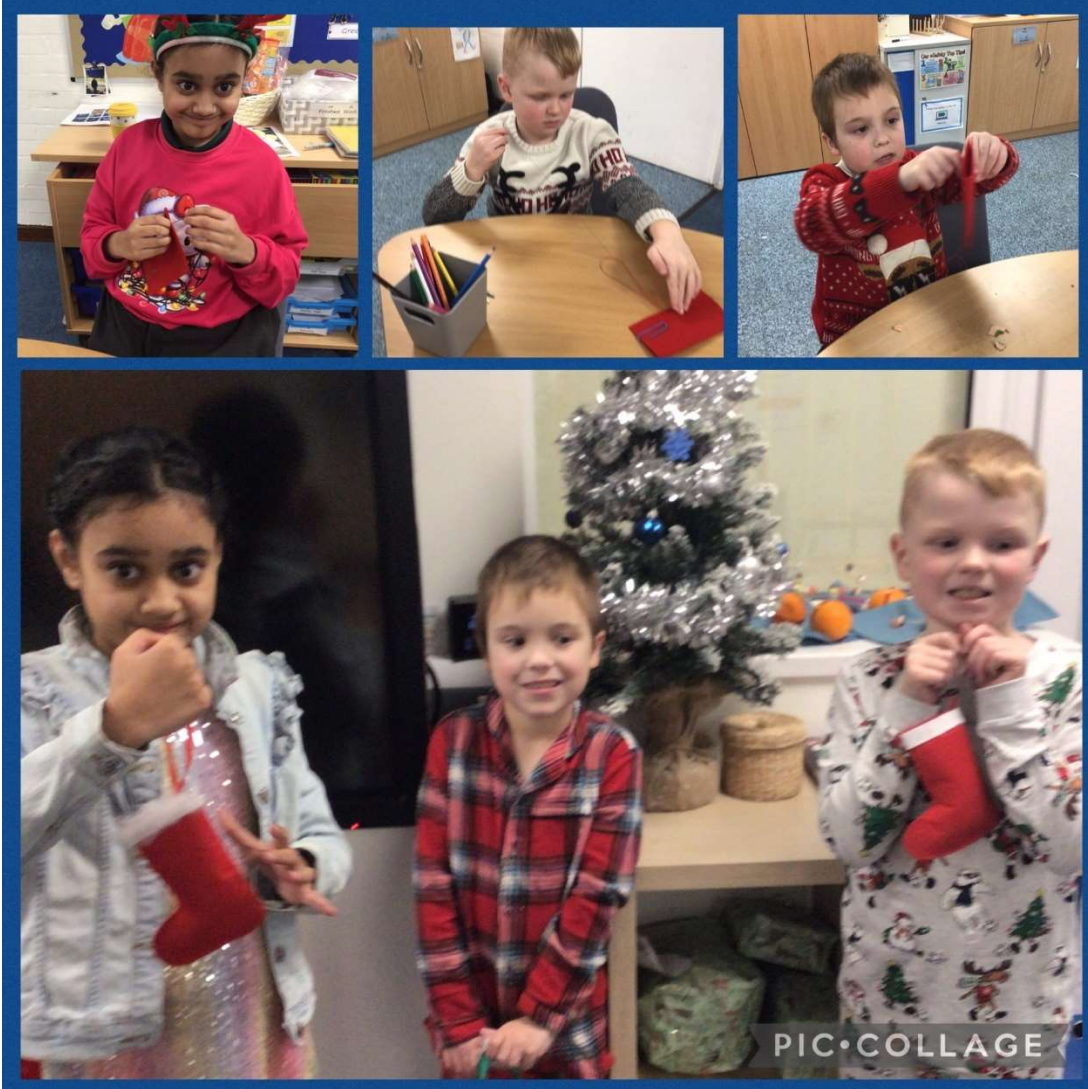


We also had two rather special visitors to Base 15.
