




**Storytime**

This week we have been reading 'What the Jackdaw Saw' by Julia Donaldson and Nick Sharratt.



**Literacy**

This half term we are reading the story, 'The Wind in the Willows'. We began by making predictions. Children were given clues about the story and then wrote and drew pictures of what they thought might happen. Then we read the beginning of the story and learned about the character Mole. Children enjoyed a range of sensory-based activities around moles, read information and created fact files.



**Numeracy**

This week we have been learning about Addition and Subtraction through a range of activities. Children have been learning to:

- Subtract by finding the difference
- Make number bonds within 10
- Make number bonds to 100 using tens

We have been working on social skills such as turn taking and sharing by playing board games in small groups.
