








Hello and welcome to another week at the hub!

This week we have been busy learning and having lots of fun in both the hub and our link classes.



In literacy, and in preparation for *Poetry Week* next week, we have been busy exploring different types of poetry. We started the lesson by listening, discussing and responding to lots of funny poems by *Julia Donaldson*. We noticed many of the poems used single-syllable rhyming words. We then used our phonic knowledge to read, find and make our own silly and funny rhyming couplets.



In maths we have continued to use non-standard and standard measure (cm & m) to order and compare length and height. We found that some of the year 2 children were taller than some of the year 1 children. We also found that George was the tallest and Harrison and Albie were the shortest.



As always, we really enjoyed our forest school session. On Monday morning, we joined our year 2 link class on the Pit Mound. We recapped how to be safe at forest school and how to sit safely around the fire pit. We then recapped our knowledge of animals and their habitats, before going on a bug hunt looking for different insects, wildlife and birds.



In PSHE, we have started our new topic 'Healthy Me'. We have been exploring sleep, hygiene and foods that are '*healthy*' and foods that are '*less healthy*' for us. We then created our own **healthy** lunch box. We also discussed the impact of these foods on our body and how exercise can support our eating habits. We are so proud of all the children, for how positively they engaged in this task, sorting, smelling and tasting a range of different foods, despite having many challenges linked to their own eating habits. Well done, guys!



In science, we have been busy recapping our knowledge of our body parts and their functions, before thinking carefully about our senses and how they help us every day. We then had lots of fun and used all our five senses, to identify a range of mystery items.


