

Literacy




Numeracy

This week we have continued learning about Addition and Subtraction through a range of activities. Children have been learning to:

- Subtract by finding the difference
- Make number bonds within 10
- Understand related addition and subtraction facts
- Add and subtract two-digit and one-digit numbers.

Class 7 loved making clay faces in Outdoor School this week. Children pressed the clay into trees and then used natural materials from the outdoor area to make features for their faces.



Topic

In our Topic, 'From A to B', we have been focusing on Science this week. We learned about air resistance and carried out a science investigation to find out which paper aeroplane would take the longest to fall to the ground. Each table was given a different variable to change for the investigation - the size of the helicopter, shape of the helicopter, or type of paper the helicopter would be made from. Children tested out their helicopters and recorded their results.
