



## News from the Hollinswood Hub: 20<sup>th</sup> March 2026


Welcome back to another week of news from the hub. This half term is flying by so quickly. We have seen some fantastic work this week, both in Base 15 and our link classes.

Here are some examples of our fantastic work:






In Maths this week, the children in year 3 have continued with their work on fractions.
