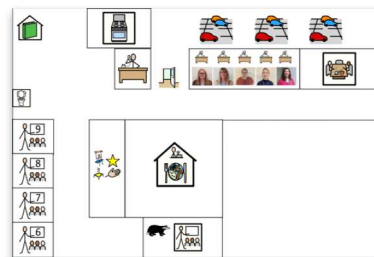
### Numeracy
