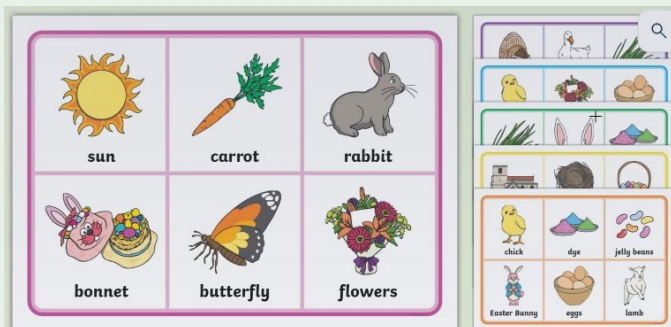


Newsletter 27th March 2026 Class 3
