We have linked our Literacy work to our RE topic by looking at the Easter Story. We sequenced key events from the story then retold it in our own words.



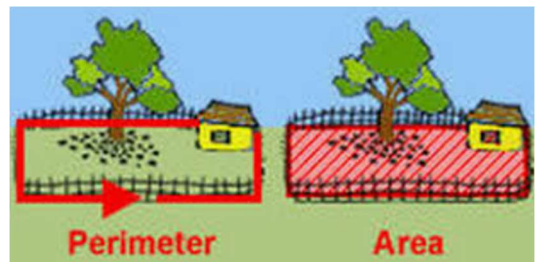
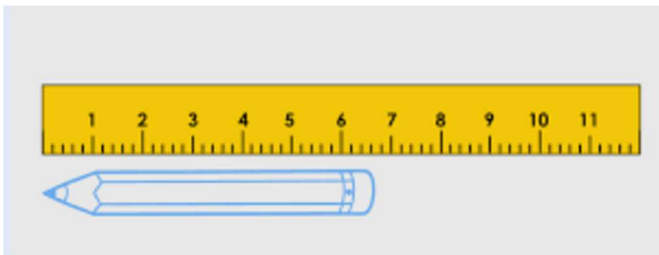
The children in year 3 joined their link classes to take part in an *Easter Experience* at Telford Minster.
