At Haughton School we follow the International Early Years Curriculum (IEYC) in Early Years and Key Stage 1 and the International Primary Curriculum (IPC) in Key Stage 2.

In our Early Years class, the children follow the foundation 1 planning from the IEYC topics. All topics are highly differentiated, follow the Early Years curriculum and are delivered in a cross-curricular way.

In Key Stage 1 the children follow a combination of foundation 1 and 2 planning from the IEYC topics. All topics are highly differentiated and are delivered in a cross-curricular way. We have identified the subject specific learning (science, history, geography, design and technology and art and design) that will take place within each of these topics.

The IPC in Key Stage 2 provides appropriate National Curriculum coverage that is delivered through highly differentiated, cross curricular topics. We use the IPC to deliver the following subjects: science, history, geography, design and technology and art and design.

With both the IPC and the IEYC each topic starts with an Entry Point which introduces the new theme to the children in a fun and exciting way.

Also, at the beginning of each topic the children undertake a Knowledge Harvest which allows an initial assessment of the children's current knowledge to take place. In each class you will see their current Knowledge Harvest on display.

At the end of each topic an Exit Point is carried out. This allows the children to celebrate and recall their learning.
