



In my outdoor learning this week, we have been exploring the colours in nature. We read the story 'Colours of Nature' by Bulbul Sharma. The children each made a colour wheel, then had to explore the forest area to find something for each colour and peg it to their wheel.

In my topic, we have been learning about growing food, which food can be grown, and what plants need to grow healthily. The children have been planting seeds and looking after the class 9 tomato plants.

In my art this week, the children have been exploring a range of drawing materials such as charcoal, paints, rollers, and pencils on different surfaces to make controlled lines, shapes and patterns.

In numeracy, our focus has been on money. Some children have been naming and identifying 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20, 50p, £1 and £2 coins, while other children have been using pre-money counters to role-play shopping to begin to understand that items can be bought and exchanged.
