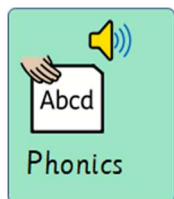
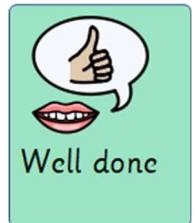




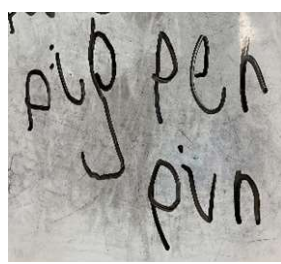
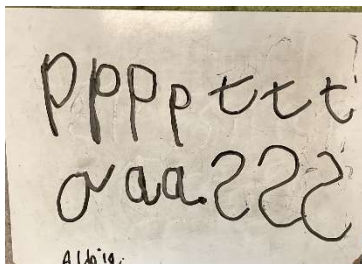
Welcome

Hello and welcome to another week of fun, learning and laughter at the hub!

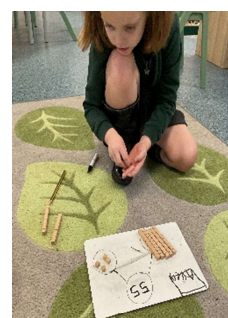
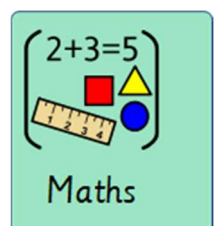
