
Class 4

Literacy

In Literacy, the children have continued reading 'Beauty and the Beast'. Everyone really enjoyed taking part in a fun quiz to see how much they remembered about the story so far! We have also been learning how to write a simple newspaper report. The children wrote about Maurice and his escape from the castle, using exciting headlines and describing what happened using word mats and colourful semantics to support their writing.





Numeracy

This week, the children have continued to build their understanding of place value. They have practised completing part / whole models by splitting numbers into tens and ones. Using base 10, the children represented different two-digit numbers to help them see how each number is made. Some children also worked on number sequences, using pictures and number tracks to spot patterns and continue the sequence correctly.



PSHE

In PSHE this week, the children have been learning about different types of decisions and who makes them. They talked about the kinds of decisions children can make and those that adults can make, especially the adults in school who help us learn and keep us safe by setting rules. The children also took part in a fun team-building activity, where they worked together to build a tower. Everyone practised taking turns, sharing ideas, and making group decisions.



Topic

This week, the children have been learning about the artist L.S Lowry. They really enjoyed looking at his industrial landscape paintings, spotting the colours, shapes and buildings in his artwork. Everyone had fun recreating one of Lowry's paintings, adding their own 'matchstick men' in his unique style! The children also remembered some interesting facts about his life and enjoyed talking about what made his paintings special.
