<u>Literacy</u>

This week we focused on the character of Maurice in 'Beauty and the Beast'. Maurice is an inventor, so the children became inventors themselves and used junk modelling to create their own inventions. We also read about Maurice getting lost in the forest, and used our senses to describe what he could see, hear, feel, and smell. Finally, we discussed whether it was the right thing for Maurice to go into the castle.



Numeracy

This week we have continued to work on our Addition and Subtraction skills through a range of practical activities. Children have been learning to:

- Subtract by finding the difference
- Find and use number bonds to 20
