Literacy

In Literacy, the children have continued to enjoy our story focus, 'Beauty and the Beast'. They have been working hard on their writing, using Colourful Semantics to help structure their ideas and build confidence with sentences. The children have written their own letters from the Beast, thinking carefully about how he might feel and what he might want to say. They also used descriptive words to create sentences about the West Wing.

In Storytime, the children listened to *Funnybones* by Janet and Allan Ahlberg.



Numeracy

This week, the children have continued to focus on place value. They have worked hard to calculate one more and one less than a given number, showing great progress in their number understanding. Some children have been using base 10 equipment to explore and identify two-digit numbers, while others have been practising writing numbers as words.



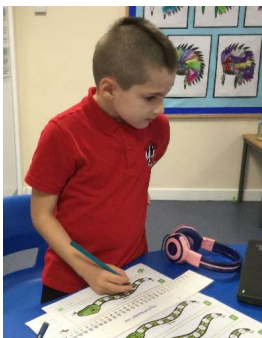
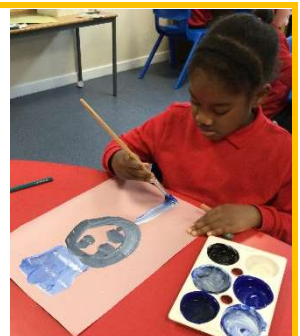
R.E

In R.E the children have been exploring the theme of kind and unkind actions. They listened carefully to the story of 'The Kind Man', learning about the importance of helping others and showing kindness. The children enjoyed retelling the main parts of the story, using pictures and discussion to recall key events. They then used sticky labels on a body outline to show how the Samaritan helped the injured man.



Topic

In our topic lessons, the children have been learning about the famous artist Pablo Picasso. They listened to a simplified story about his life and showed understanding of his 'Blue Period' when he created paintings to express feelings of sadness. The children practised mixing shades of blue using paint. They then used these skills to create their own self-portraits in blue, inspired by Picasso's unique style.
