Numeracy

This week we have continued to work on our Addition and Subtraction skills through a range of practical activities. Children have been learning to:

- Understand a part-whole model
- Make addition and subtraction fact families
- Use doubles and near doubles
- Write number sentences



Literacy

In Literacy this week, we read about the new characters that Maurice meets in the castle and imagined casting a magic spell on objects to make them come alive. The children chose an object they would bring to life and wrote about what it would say. Children then looked at the inside of the Beast's castle and described what they could see. We also ordered events from the story.



Topic

This week in our 'People of the Past' topic, we learned about the composer, Mozart. Children listened to his music and talked about how it made them feel, and they also enjoyed playing along to the rhythm using body percussion. We learned key facts about Mozart's life and created fact files. Children also composed their own rhythm and made musical instruments.
