



This week children have thought about, and been learning about, Remembrance Day. We have completed lots of activities and finished off the week by going out on the school mini bus to see poppies out in the community. The children really enjoyed seeing them especially those in Madeley. In Madeley we saw different coloured ones not only on lampposts but on the metal horse and cart, as well as on many of the railings and buildings.

We made poppy biscuits in literacy and decorated them with red icing and a chocolate button. The children enjoyed eating them across the week including on the day, at Outdoor School and whilst on our trip. Other activities have included, exploring sparkly red GelliBaff, red and green magnetic tiles, copying pictures to make poppies, making a poppy picture and making the wreath that is now hung outside school. Children watched short videos about why we wear poppies and will all take part in a remembrance assembly next Tuesday in the Hall.
