

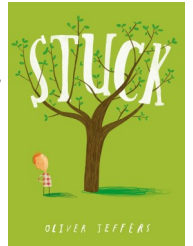

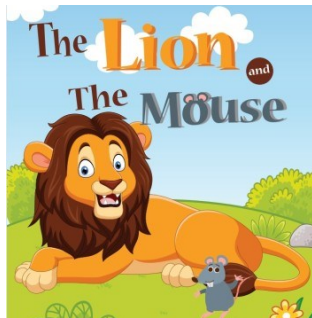
Storytime

Literacy

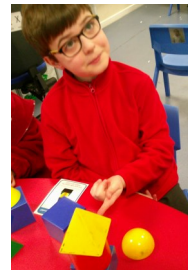

Numeracy

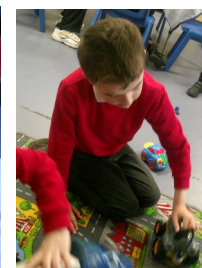
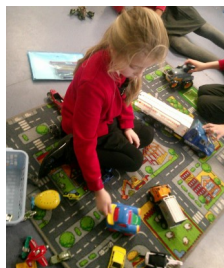
This week we have continued to learn about Shape through a range of practical activities. Children have been learning to:

- Identify 2D and 3D shapes
- Sort 2D and 3D shapes
- Identify lines of symmetry and draw shapes
- Count the sides on 2D shapes



Topic

Our Topic this half term is called 'From A to B'. Children are going to be learning geography skills such as reading maps, and learning about different types of transport. For our Entry Point, the class enjoyed exploring transport through play. We then learned about cars, and children looked at the different parts for a car and what they are used for. We also looked at what cars looked like a long time ago and sorted old and new cars. Children enjoyed exploring cars in different ways such as rolling them down a ramp, and role playing a car wash.
