


Class 12!

Class 12's new Topic is all about 'Feel the force' looking at magnets, friction, gravity etc. The Children have enjoyed taking part in investigations linked to friction and finding out which materials (rough and bumpy) would have more impact on the cars speed along the ramp (as you can see in the image above).
