

Class 12!

Class 12 have had a lovely, relaxed week despite the poor weather! The relationships the children are making with each other are truly amazing and it is so nice to see.

In Literacy we are on to our last week looking at 'Stitch's Valentine!' Class 12 have really enjoyed this story due to some relevance of what they enjoy outside of School. This week we have looked at how Stitch was feeling when he had not received any cards or Valentines day and looking at different adjectives to describe his emotions during this time. We then used our Outdoor School to find pictures of Angel, using our sight sense and listening to instructions to help find different pictures through Hide and Seek.



In Numeracy this week we have been looking more in detail at shape, in particular 'pattern making using 2-D and 3-D shapes.' 'Drawing 2-D Shapes.' And finally, 'Measuring and drawing accurately using rulers.'

Through Class 12's Topic lessons we have been learning about 'Feel the force' looking at magnets, friction, gravity etc. The Children have learnt about gravity this week, gaining an understanding of what gravity is, how it affects us as humans and objects around us. The children have completed an investigation attempting to design their own parachute and watch objects fall down, visually seeing the impact of gravity.

We have had Music sessions on a Tuesday afternoon which the children have thoroughly enjoyed, sitting in a circle using collaborative skills to compose a piece of music together.
