

## Numeracy


In Numeracy some of us have been working on number and place value. We have been:

- ◆ Counting from 50 to 100
- ◆ Comparing numbers within 10
- ◆ Comparing groups by matching
- ◆ Using vocabulary less than, greater than and equal to
- ◆ Counting by making groups of 10
- ◆ Identifying one more/one less to 20
- ◆ Ordering numbers on a number line to 50

- ◆ Comparing and ordering non-unit fractions
