In Maths this week, we have started our new topic all about measures. We have been using rulers and meter sticks to help us to measure length and height accurately.



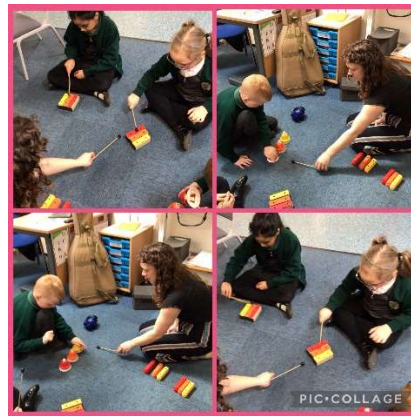

History
