Literacy



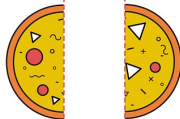
This week we have continued reading “Beauty and the beast”. The children have been introduced to new character Belle’s father Maurice. They have become inventors just like him and used their imagination to invent something new. They come up with some wonderful and creative ideas. The children also answered who, doing, what questions whilst recalling some parts of the story.

Numeracy

This week the children have been working on Shape and Fractions.

Some children have been:

- Recognising and naming 3D shapes
- Recognising a half of an object or shape
- Finding 2D shapes within 3D shapes.



Topic

This week we have continued our topic “Green Fingers”. In class, we have carried out an experiment with our big question being “Do plants need sunlight?” We carried out a fair test and planted some seeds into soil. The first plant went into the dark cupboard, the second plant went into an area of the classroom with little sunlight and the third plant went onto the window sill with lots of sunlight. We have made our predictions and will observe the plants over time and record the results.
