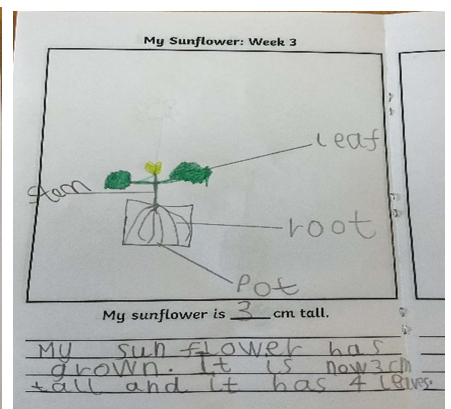
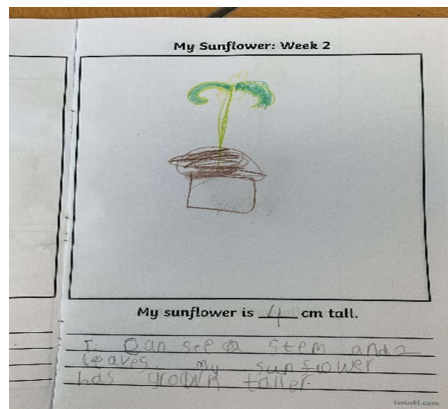
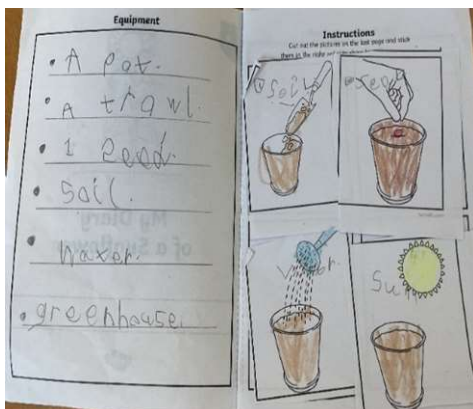
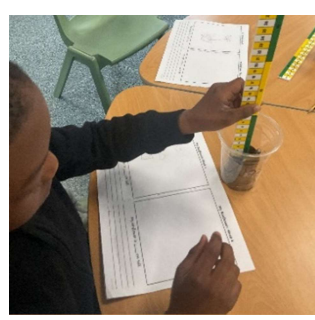
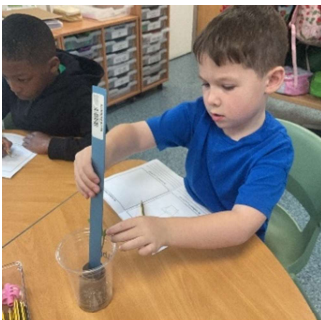
Hello and welcome to the hub!

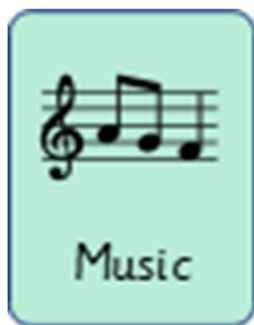

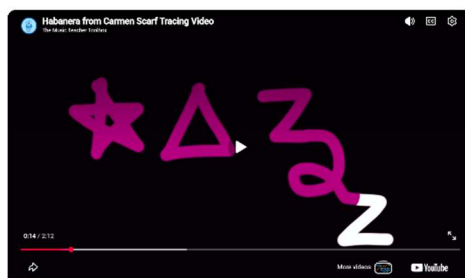

This week in DT, the children have used their knowledge of healthy and unhealthy foods to plan a healthy lunch box, before designing and planning a healthy sandwich.

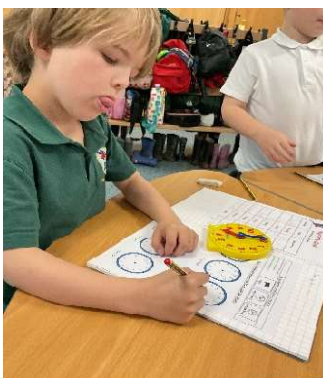


They all successfully touched, smelt, licked or tasted a range of healthy fillings to help them decide what filling to use next week.



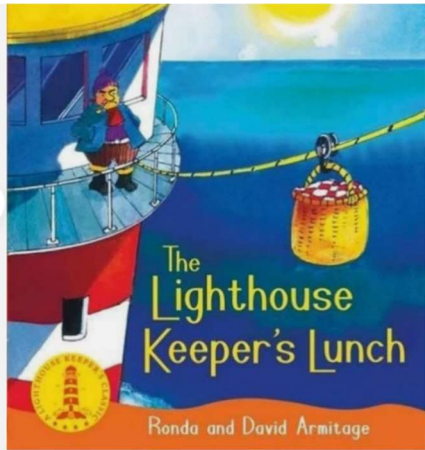

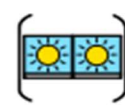
