School Swimming Sessions – Autumn Term (1)
Change to Swimming Dates

During planned maintenance at the Abraham Pool, some unforeseen issues were discovered that need to be fixed before the pool can re-open. Due to this, children are unable to go swimming next Wednesday (23 September).

The revised swimming dates are:

Class	First Session	Last Session
Butterflies (Mrs Jeffries)	Wednesday 30 September	Wednesday 9 December
Owls (Mr D Taylor)	Wednesday 30 September	Wednesday 28 October
Woodpeckers (Mr Bradney)	Wednesday 30 September	Wednesday 28 October

(Key stage 1 and 2 children swim on a rota basis throughout the year. Butterflies class swim all year round).

Children will travel in the school minibus or a staff vehicle (with appropriate business insurance).

Swimming sessions are part of the National Curriculum and therefore it is essential that your child brings their swimwear (including a towel) into school when required.
Please ensure that all belongings are clearly labelled.



Children learning to swim will be wearing a SwimFin flotation aid.
If you would prefer your child to wear armbands you will need to send in a suitable pair from home and they must be already inflated.
